## **Device Access**

#### **Policy Opportunity:**

• Increase the Wisconsin PSC's Nonprofit Access grant program to meet the device needs of unserved residents.

## **Skills Access**

Everyone needs digital skills and literacy to maximize the opportunities provided by our digital society, including education, healthcare, employment, and social inclusion.

## **Policy Opportunity:**

• Make the Capital Projects Fund Digital Connectivity & Navigators grant program permanent.

## **Broadband Access**

As the world becomes more connected, people without internet access risk being left behind. Access to affordable, fast, reliable broadband across our community empowers everyone to fully participate in society.

## **Policy Opportunities:**

- Formalize local governments' commitment to support the Milwaukee Broadband Partnership as the official coordinating group to address broadband access.
- Incentivize community-based organizations to own, operate, and scale broadband service.
- Support reintroduction of The Affordable Connectivity Program Extension Act to extend the Affordable Connectivity Program.
- Promote existing lifeline resources; expand eligibility and funding levels to include more low-income Wisconsin households.
- Expand low-cost broadband subscriptions from internet service providers. Enact affordability standards for low-income/cost-burdened communities with lower-than-average broadband adoption rates.
